

VIII. LIBRARY POLICIES

A. LIBRARY BILL OF RIGHTS STATEMENT AND FREEDOM TO READ

The Board of Trustees of the Southmost Union Junior College District affirms the propositions adopted by the Arnulfo L. Oliveira Memorial Library in accordance with the “Library Bill of Rights” and the “Freedom to Read” statements of the American Library Association (as it appears in Library Policy Manual #P107).

B. LIBRARY PRIVILEGES

1. Faculty, staff and students will have full access to the collection and may check out materials as appropriate.
2. Members of the community residing within the College District may use the collection within the facility but may not check out materials.
3. Members of the public residing outside the College District may pay a fee, in lieu of tax support, and use the collection in the facility but may not check out materials.
4. Limited exceptions may be made on a temporary basis for the use of the collection by visiting students, scholars and other person with specific research needs. These limited, temporary users may not check out materials.
