

GRADUATE SUCCESS

UTB/TSC held its largest commencements ever in 2002-2003. More than 1,500 students earned certificates, associate, bachelor's, or master's degree. Among these were 184 graduate degrees. In total, more than 11,000 people have earned a degree at UTB/TSC. Other indicators of the success of our graduates are employment and the pursuit of higher levels of education.

EMPLOYMENT IN FIELD OF STUDY

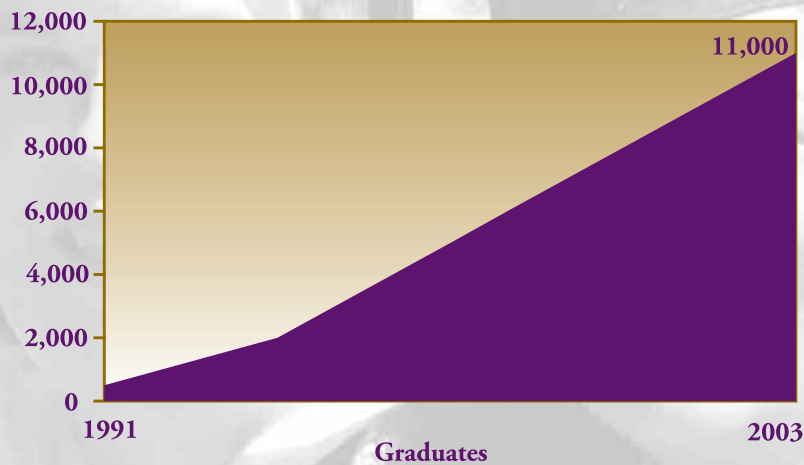
Of the approximately 1,200 people graduating in Fall 2001 and Spring 2002, 244 responded to a non-random survey administered by the office of

Institutional Research during Commencement. Of the 244 respondents, 70 percent reported being employed at the time the survey was administered. More than half of the respondents reported having a job directly related to their field of study.

FUTURE EDUCATIONAL PLANS

A total of 244 people responded to a survey during the fall and spring commencements, 199 of them (or 81 percent) said that they plan to continue their education either at the undergraduate or graduate levels.
