## ITECC General Information (cont.)

The ITECC infrastructure and surroundings will be developed with an adaptable infrastructure which can accommodate ever changing technologies. Additional characteristics should include:

A physical signature which identifies it instantly with UTB/TSC.

A self-contained academic and training community which will be a model and catalyst for re-development of surrounding neighborhoods as well as downtown revitalization.

Include academic lower, upper, and graduate division classes as well as house faculty in order to expand learning opportunities.

### Access and entryways -

The ITECC occupies a large site with access from three roads. The 6th Street access depends on its proposed extension.

The traditional principal entrance to the property is from Mexico Boulevard. This entrance provides opportunity to introduce the new identity for the ITECC through a revised architectural character to the campus. This entrance will become a promenade with a divided four lane approach. Palm trees will flank the promenade. The drive, paved to provide texture and color, terminates in a landscaped round-about. Depending on future facility needs, the master plan lays out the development of future buildings at either side of the promenade to help the pedestrian scale and enhance the approach to the campus.
