



## ITECC Elevations

The entrance to the Praxedis Orive, Jr. Technical Training Center (1) is located off Palm Boulevard. Heavy student traffic is expected in this area, and the planning accommodates for this demand. This functional entrance affords automobile access from the street, and easy pedestrian circulation from the plentiful parking areas.

Once 6th Street is extended across the railroad tracks, a new major entrance (2) is possible because of the direct connection to the downtown area and the UTB/TSC campus. This entrance is treated similarly to the entrance off Mexico Boulevard, with a divided promenade, row of palm trees and pavers.

Secondary entrances such as to the Central plant, Child Development Center and Workforce Training and Continuing Education are treated in a functional and non obtrusive way to avoid competition with the major entrances.





## ITECC Elevations (cont.)

Facing the Resaca, the north elevation of the building serves as the entrance to the UTB/TSC Exhibition Center. The plan incorporates a new façade treatment to honor this use, and envisions a large hardscaped plaza with a water feature. The plaza accommodates public gatherings and large object exhibits.
